



Customized Agency Emergency Planning Assistance NOW AVAILABLE (through June 30, 2016)

CADRE is pleased to announce that FREE planning assistance is now available to a limited number of Santa Clara County CADRE member organizations -- Community-based Organizations (CBOs) and Faith-based Organizations (FBOs) -- under a small grant we have received from Santa Clara County's Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) program for this fiscal year.

This program is designed to help CBOs and FBOs with their own organization's emergency planning and disaster preparedness efforts. A newly created customized Agency Emergency Planning Toolkit will be made available to each CADRE member agency selected to receive assistance. In addition, we will work to support your disaster planning efforts and strengthen your relationship building by connecting you with local city emergency managers and other CBO leaders as needed.

Agencies who are interested in applying for this year's program are invited to fill out the form below and email it to admin@cadresv.org for consideration. Priority will be given to agencies who will play a lead role in assisting the CADRE Network with operational coordination and planning. If your agency is selected, you will be contacted by CADRE staff to assess:

- Where your agency currently stands with disaster and emergency planning for your organization
- What help or assistance is needed or desired
- Who is available from your agency to work with CADRE staff and your local City emergency manager

Note: due to the funding source, this service is limited to Santa Clara County organizations.
